Risking to Trust in Dialogue - 48:00 33:00 Summary of Changes to the CPO O&M in order to conduct a 3RE (Restore, Rekindle, Renew Enrichment)

As with all the first presentations in a session, a Recap and Question & Answer time precede the main body of this presentation.

- that last session provided a great view from the spot we had climbed

We are on the final approach to the summit. We ask you to trust us – the payoff is great!
