

HOW TO USE THE POWERPOINT FOR CPO 3RE:

There are 7 separate files (assuming 7 sessions for the 3RE). Some were created in Office Powerpoint 2003, showing ".ppt" ending; some in later version with ".pptx" ending. You will definitely want to look through these files, as opening them with a different version of PowerPoint might change them a little.

You will also want to review the slides connected with the presentation you will be leading so that you are familiar with the timing of transitions and how many "clicks" it takes to bring up the points, for instance. Do you want to personalize them in any way? Have you changed any of the suggested PDA handouts so that the slides no longer match them?

In addition:

- I. Do you want to add contact information to the slide or just have the title?
- II. Is the Aldonza song "embedded" in the slide or do you need to work on this to make it happen, or are you planning to play a CD at this point?
- V. Is the Dulcinea song "embedded" in the slide or do you need to work on this to make it happen, or are you planning to play a CD at this point?
- VI. Is the song "If Tomorrow Never Comes" "embedded" in the slide or do you need to work on this to make it happen, or are you planning to play a CD at this point?
- VII. Is the song "Impossible Dream" "embedded" in the slide or do you need to work on this to make it happen, or are you planning to play a CD at this point?

You might also want to replace the photos of couples in this slide with some of your own local Community events.

The music for such embedding is also part of this CD, and can also be found on ELF, Team Pillar, WWME version of 3RE documents. The media file is a video with "Mission Impossible" music which you could use, but the visual includes a priest as well as a couple.
