"RENEWING THE VISION" ... is the focus of NAR Lutheran Marriage Encounter for the next three years. A Gospel Call for renewal is St. Paul's invitation in Romans chapter 12, verse 2: "Do not conform yourselves to the standards of this world, but let God transform you inwardly by a complete change of your mind. Then you will be able to know the will of God—what is good and is pleasing to God and is perfect."

Some of the highlights of topics covered in the strategic planning sessions are:



- RELATION-SHIPS—with God, with each other and with others.
- MINISTRY—as Self Serving versus Self Giving and/ or Ministry versus TASK!
- COMMITMENT—Going through difficult times together and working through them.
- ♥ PRIORITIZING focus of LME ministry—
 - Mentoring
 - Marketing
 - Clergy Involvement
 - Post-Weekend Commitment
 - Nurturing Leadership Couples

Post Weekend Commitment—Every couple off a weekend to dialogue daily, involvement in Community activities, and live a Marriage Encounter lifestyle.

- All loving tasks will be filled in all Areas, always.
- 25% of couples off the weekends will be involved in a Love Circle.
- ♥ 25% of couples off the weekends will send at least one other couple on a weekend.
- ♥ 25% of couples off a weekend will be a Prayer Couple at least once in the first year.

Nurturing leadership—Every couple called to leadership will be nourished and nourish others for ministry.

Clergy—will support Lutheran Marriage Encounter and recognize it as a viable ministry of the Church.

Enrichment Experiences—Get beyond talking about it and move on to providing some kind of opportunity for Area Presenting Couples. For example:

- Discovery Weekends
- ♥ Leadership Training Retreats
- ♥ Love Languages
- Attend new Deeper Weekend with updated format.

The goal is for presenting couples to participate on an enrichment weekend once a year.

Any events scheduled for presenting couple enrichments should be sent to Carl and Dallas Presley (NAR Secretary Couple; see Leadership Listings for how to contact them) or distribution to ALL Areas for dissemination across ALL Districts.

PRAY— for the enthusiasm of those who had ministry positions in the past to mentor and support the newly encountered to fill the 'Loving Ministry' positions.

PRAY—that our Lord will instill a sense of "Call" to newly encountered couples, and renew the vision and sense of Call to those encountered in the past twenty-five years.

COMPONENTS of a PRAYER LETTER

To assist you in this Loving Ministry, here is a brief outline of what to include in your Prayer Letter to your special couple:

- Let them know you are praying for them
- Tell them the special things you are doing this Weekend on their behalf (Offering your Worship, Candle burning, Fasting, etc.)
- What your hopes and dreams are for them.
- God's Unconditional Love for them.
