## LUTHERAN MARRIAGE ENCOUNTER KICKOFF III OUTLINE AND WRITING GUIDELINES

## I. PRAYER

- II. WELCOME (One member)
  - Thank all the presenting couples for coming and the host couple for opening their home.
  - Introduce yourself, then share your spouse's endearing quality.
  - Give the date of your original Weekend, how long you have been a presenting couple and which set of talks you are currently presenting.
  - Invite everyone to do the same by going around the room. [To include those still writing who haven't given a Weekend yet, you may wish to ask for the set of talks they are writing.]
- III. INTRODUCTION (1/2 min.)
  - This presentation is different from others, being exclusively for them as Lutheran Marriage Encounter presenters.
  - Briefly tell them what a Kickoff III is a very special time to share and that calls for a yes or no answer from each of them, to recommit to being a presenting couple for Lutheran Marriage Encounter.

## IV. ROMANCE, DISILLUSIONMENT AND JOY AS A PRESENTING COUPLE (3-5 min. each)

#### ROMANCE

- The first person sharing in this section should include a short lead-in.
  - This may include that just as the cycle of Romance and Disillusionment, and the state of joy repeat in our couple relationship, they also occur in other relationships; and now we are focusing on our Romance, Disillusionment and Joy in being a presenting couple.
- The Romance section should include your feelings and thoughts from both the time you were originally asked to be a presenting couples as well as the romance as it occurs now, actively being a presenting couple.

This is an "I" section, so share only yourself as you look back. In all parts of IV, include your personality style where applicable.

• This is not a complete list by any means, but here are some suggestions to look at:

Being asked to be a presenting couple Did you struggle with the decision? Were your expectations of being presenters part of your romance? Someone encouraged us - HDIFAT?

Kickoff I & II - did being a presenting couple sound exciting? Excitement and anticipation of a Deeper Weekend Looking ahead to writing - were you excited for the closeness you expected to gain?

Anticipation of that first Weekend as presenters Anticipation of any Weekend you give Your dreams - did ILME seem to be the "perfect" organization? Did you look forward to belonging to ILME? Was the idea of working "together" appealing? Did you have expectations for growth in your couple relationship? Did you have expectations for growth in your couple or individual relationship with God? Were you excited to see Participants on the weekend bloom?

(Although the above ideas may seem focused on the early experiences as a presenting couple, it is important to also use examples of current Romance.)

#### **DISILLUSIONMENT** (1 - 1.5 min. each)

- Your own personal disillusionment: bring out your feelings, judgments and attitudes that come about because of the kind of person you are.
   You need to be careful here not to blame others for your disillusionment.
- Here are some suggestions you may want to use. This list is not intended to be complete.
   You may have other disillusionments that you want to share.
  - Preparing for Weekends Writing talks Rewriting talks Workshopping Being workshopped Pre- and post-Weekend letters Getting baby-sitters

Seeing a lack of commitment in yourself Is writing sharing letters a chore? Are we saying "yes" to being a prayer couple? Are we active in community? Have we lost the focus of the Weekend? Do we still have a vision for ILME and the world? Are we living the Weekend concepts?

#### JOY (1 - 1/5 min. each)

Share the Joy relating to being presenters -- It should include examples of joy both from preparing and presenting a Weekend, and from your personal growth as a couple. Listed are a few areas you may want to look at for examples.

#### V. SHARING

- The introduction for the sharing for Kickoff III is similar to the introduction of sharing for Cana and Weekend Renewal. The section should be brief but clear.
- It is important for the presenting couples to understand what we are asking is for them to share their feelings about their own Romance, Disillusionment and Joy in being a presenting couple. We are not asking for stories, accounts or dissertations on some of the things that have happened to them while they have been presenters.
- Stress the unique opportunity we all have here, and don't let periods of silence be a distraction.
- Encourage someone to be first
- $\circ~$  Thank all the couples for supporting each other both through their gifts of sharing and gifts of listening.

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SPONSIBILITIES (2-3 min. – divide between presenters)

## VIII. RECOMMITMENT AND WRAP-UP (1 min.)

- This section is intended to explain that at one time each of the presenting couples made a commitment to the responsibilities of being a presenting couple and now they have the opportunity to commit once again.
- $\circ$   $\;$  Ask them to think about it, pray about it, dialogue about it and talk about it.
- Remind them that it is still a decision that they must make as a couple. Both must be willing to make the commitment.
- Ask them to reconsider their commitment as a presenting couple and to call or write to the presenting couple coordinator by the deadline. (This date will also be indicated on the handout.)
- Tell them you have a handout for them and explain the responsibilities and dialogue handout.
- o Close by thanking them all for attending Kickoff III. You may want to finish with a prayer.

- How has being a presenting couple affected members of our family? HDIFAT?
- What effect have we had on other couples and individuals by being a presenting couple? HDIFAT?

For those of you who may be writing talks and have not yet given a Weekend, please use the following questions:

- How has writing affected me as an individual? HDIFAT?
- How has writing affected our relationship? HDIFAT?
- How has writing affected members of our family? HDIFAT?

We also ask you to make a special attempt to be at our meeting. We are looking forward to the opportunity to be with you once again.
