Call to Be Family dba Lutheran Marriage Encounter North American Region Mid-year Financial Report May 2018

OVERVIEW

The 2018 Year-to-date as of May 31, 2018 Financial Report shows statistically no change in our financial status. Our account balances do have a slight decrease of \$3,573 which is less than 1 ½% of beginning balances. This is statistically insignificant because end-of-year donations and investment gains/losses will easily offset this difference. Our program activities (Weekends) show the same number of events (10) but significantly fewer attendees (from 118 in 2017 to 89 in 2018). This is nearly a 25% drop in the number of attendees for comparable periods. We included the outreach to India for Experience statistics

For mid-year reporting the results do not include significant analysis of revenues and expenditures. What I do report is the simple status of accounts. In simple numbers, our accounts have a balance of \$241,514.22 which is a decrease of \$3,573 from the 2017 year-end balance of \$245,086.81. The total is allocated with approximately \$95,000 in DREAM funds and \$150,000 in operating funds. Precise allocation to the funds will be done at the end of the year.

The DREAM Fund had reduced assets due to the expenses of the marketing programs, and expenses paid out for the India Outreach. The result of the India Outreach has an unspent budget balance of \$4,595.61. This is due primarily to donations in excess of the approved budget and significantly lower travel costs for the Outreach presenters. The NAR Board will need to determine what to do with the budget surplus. Options include: Leave this as allocated funds in DREAM accounts for Phase-2 or other India future expenses, de-allocate the funds and return the balance to either operating accounts or Dream-Fund general accounts.

Experience Statistics

As reported in the overview, we held 10 North American weekends which matches 10 in the comparable 2017 period. For the current year there has been a significant drop in the number of couples encountered in North America dropping from 118 to 89. This I a 24.6% drop for one-half year of experiences.

Listed below are the basic results for the number of Experiences for the comparable periods in 2017 and 2018.
