Current By-Laws (2006)

MINIMUM CRITERIA FOR AREAS:

1. An Area has geographical boundaries with leadership, an administrative board and presenting couples to support local weekends. An Area must have at least three (3) presenting couples who have talks weekend-ready. It is highly desirable but not necessary that one of these couples be a Clergy Couple. Areas with fewer than three presenting couples shall be considered "Outreach Areas."

2. Each Area will establish an Area Lay Contact Couple in a manner to be determined within the Area. The Area Lay Contact Couple need not be a Presenting Couple, but must have attended a weekend within the prior five (5) years or during their term of office.

Proposed By-Law Changes

- **B.** DEFINITIONS AND EXPECTATIONS:
 - 1. An Area has *broad* geographical boundaries agreed to by the District Leadership Team. It is expected that adjacent Areas cooperate with each other with a sense of "family" to assist and support each other in away that is not territorial An Area must have a commitment to actively promote weekend attendance in their own or other Areas as well as to actively pursue all aspects of the Vision and Mission of Lutheran Marriage Encounter. District Leadership may alter geographic boundaries or deactivate an Area after prayerful consideration and coordination with the Area community. All reasonable effort shall be made to keep an Area functioning and viable
 - 2. Each Area will establish an Area Contact Couple (Lay and clergy if possible) in a manner to be determined within the Area and agreed to by the District Leadership Team. The Area Lay Contact Couple need not be a Presenting Couple, but must have attended a weekend within the prior five (5) years or during their term of office.

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3. Each Area will establish an Area Clergy Contact Couple preferably from the weekend-ready Clergy Presenting Couple community within the Area. If there are no weekend-ready Clergy Presenting Couples within the Area who are able or willing to serve, the position may be filled by an encountered Clergy Couple, otherwise the position shall be declared vacant.

- 4. The Area Lay and Clergy Contact Couples provide leadership in the Area and will represent the Area on the District Board. If there is no Clergy Contact Couple, only the Area Lay Contact Couple will represent the Area on the District Board.
- 5. The District Executive Team may decide how or whether an Outreach Area is represented on the District Board.

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- The Area Presenting Couple Coordinator (APCC) is an Area coleadership position. If there are three (3) or more presenting couples in an Area, the presenters will determine which among them will fulfill the responsibilities of the APCC. If there are fewer than three presenting couples in an Area, one of the presenters may be designated as the APCC or they may choose to have the DPCC serve as the Area APCC. If a presenting couple does not live within an established Area, the DPCC will serve as their APCC or the DPCC may designate the nearest APCC to serve in that capacity.
- 4. The Area Contact Couple (s) (Lay and Clergy if possible) provide leadership in the Area and will represent the Area on the District Board. At the option of the District Leadership Team, APCCs may be invited to attend the District Board meeting after due consideration to the needs of the District and financial stewardship.
- 5. The District Executive Team may decide how or whether an Outreach Area is represented on the District Board.
