FEBRUARY 19, 2011 DISTRICT 1 LEADERSHIP MEETING:

ENRICHMENT SESSION: Dr. Gary Chapman's "LOVE LANGUAGES"



May 21, 2011 - 17 couples (including 1 pre-encountered couple) attended the KYRAP Workshop "Laugh Your Way to a Better Marriage Session 2" in Solon, OH. Deaf interpreters and closed captioning allowed for full participation by the hearing impaired.

July 8-10, 2011 - **20 families** (95 people) attended the "Storybook Adventures" Themed Family Campout in Louisville, OH. Three newly encountered families attended.
