# NEW OUTLINE UPDATE—Now working on "Self"

As reported in the previous Hotline, the drafts of 3 talks (the combined Intro and Feelings talk to be given on Friday night, the Today's World Talk, and the Listening talk) have been sent to the various faith expressions, comments received, and adjustments made. The Friday night combined talk is now being piloted across the US and Canada so they can evaluate how well this will actually work on a Weekend.

We have just received the draft of "Encounter With Self," and the Lutheran committee is currently sending comments on this talk to the compilers of the suggestions, Carl and Dallas Presley. The major change in the Outline Committee draft for this talk is the replacement of The Prince and the Rose story by the Aldonza song from "The Man of La Mancha" to illustrate how we can become trapped in our own self doubts. Other changes include the shortening of several sections, i.e. the description of personality styles and the description of behaviors are shortened by 1 minute and a half-minute respectively.

We thank the committee for taking their valuable time to review these drafts and make suggestions. It is a very tedious process, but we appreciate the efforts of these people to make the talks as good as possible. We are only one of 11 faith expressions making comments, so just a reminder that whatever suggestions we submit may or may not be implemented at the discretion of the Outline Committee.


