How are we doing on the re-writes?

We hope all of you 2nd, 3rd, and Clergy writers have finished the Friday night re-writes of the combined Intro-Feelings talk and that <u>all writers</u> are well on your way to finishing the rewrites of the three 1st set talks: Self, Listening and Risk. If you need the

information again as to how to get the outlines, go to: ww.ilme.org> Resources for Couples who have been on a Weekend > Presenting Couples (enter password: LME/pc) > find document called: CPO Outlines & Workbook Pages. There is now a folder for each talk, and under each talk you will find: the Skeletal Outline, the Outline and Mentality, a template (which many find simplifies the writing because all of the formatting is done for you and the suggested wording is already placed in the talk), and the new Workbook pages that will go with this change. If talks are released as expected, the goal set by NAR is to change over to all new talks in September of 2013.

And late-breaking news flash: The new 2nd Set talk "Marriage In Today's World" outline has just been released and is now being posted on the www.ilme.org website, so you may access this talk outline, mentality, template, and workbook pages at this same location.

Self talk reminder:

Just a reminder of the change that was made in the Self talk: Clergy now have a choice to read either the Isaiah passage or the Psalms passage or both, and they then also do the next section: VI. B commenting on your personal reaction to the scripture. First Set writers need to be aware that they no longer give section VI.B (your reaction to these passages.)
