## NOMINATIONS FOR NAR POSITIONS DUE BY APRIL 30



The 3-year term of NAR Clergy Exec Couple, Dan & Judy Teuscher, and Lay Exec Couple, Dean & Marcia Redman, is ending this summer. Elections will take place August 16-18 at the NAR Board Meeting in St. Louis. Nominations must be submitted to Redmans or Teuschers by April 30. Any encountered couple can nominate qualified couples for the NAR Executive positions. As soon as a nomination has been received and eligibility

confirmed, Redmans and Teuschers will contact the nominated couple to confirm their interest and send the dialogue questions and a questionnaire for them to complete and return no later than June 15. Please give prayerful consideration to couples you know who have a passion and commitment for this ministry. Following are some qualities and responsibilities that may help you identify these people. (You may also find this information and the nomination form posted on the <a href="https://www.ilme.org">www.ilme.org</a> website.)

#### **DESIRABLE LEADERSHIP QUALITIES:**

- Commitment to each other, God, daily dialogue and Lutheran Marriage Encounter
- Vision using the history of LME to realize its effect on the present and future of the
  organization, including skills of long-range planning and thinking outside the box enough to
  carry out the mission in the future.
- Knowledge, understanding and willingness to learn
- Creativity in the solution of old and new problems
- Passion for marriage as an institution and the marriages of individual couples, including themselves.
- Willingness to share and delegate tasks and responsibilities, giving authority to other couples.
- Ability to inspire and stimulate members of the Board in their own leadership and in passion to live out the concepts of the Weekend in their daily lives.
- Trustworthiness, honesty, integrity, patience in dealing with others.
- Flexibility and common sense in applying guidelines in this organization of loving volunteers.
- Thick skin and care enough to love and forgive even in the face of rejection or criticism
- Wisdom & gentleness
- Initiative & communication with other lovers
- And the greatest of these is LOVE

#### **CONSIDERATIONS FOR REGIONAL EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP:**

- 1. Must be committed to and practicing the gift of Daily Dialogue
- 2. Must be able to commit a sizable amount of time to this loving task
- 3. Will be responsible for co-chairing and preparing the agenda for Regional Board meetings, which usually take place twice a year sometimes in Europe.

- 4. Are authorized to administer and conduct all business affairs of the Region in accordance with the By-laws and other guidelines and policies
- 5. Will create and delete Staff positions as needed, and will appoint and coordinate Regional Staff as needed (a minimum of Secretary and Finance Couples)
- 6. Will appoint standing committees of the NAR Board and serve as ex-officio members
- 7. Will attend the Interfaith Board meetings (usually twice a year)
- 8. Develop and foster a strong family relationship with the European Region and the Brazilian Outreach Area, attend an annual meeting of the ILME Board (alternates between a North America and a Europe location)
- 9. Maintain open lines of communication within the LME structure and Encountered Couples everywhere.

# BY-LAW PROVISIONS FOR ELECTIONS OF NORTH AMERICAN REGION EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP

Per the By-laws, the North American Region shall elect one Regional Executive Lay Couple and one Regional Executive Clergy couple.

- They are primarily responsible for the administration of the North American Region
- They will decide which among them will serve as the President and Vice President of the corporation
- They will represent the Region on the ILME council
- They will also represent the Region in the relationship with Worldwide Marriage Encounter
- They will represent the Lutheran Region at meetings of the WWME Interfaith Board
- The term of office is one three-year term with no elected couple serving more than one consecutive term (to begin with the conclusion of the August meeting elections or at the end of the International Council meeting, whichever is later, but no later than Sept. 1 of that year)
- They must be a presenting couple, the lay couple being chosen from the third-set presenting couples. (If this is not possible, they must be chosen from current or past District Contact Couples.)
- Both Executive Lay Couple and Executive Clergy Couple must reside in North American Region.

Per paragraph III.D. of the By-laws, this is the voting process:

- Election voting will occur by written secret ballot, one vote per couple eligible to vote.
- The out-going Regional Executive Team and the District Executive Teams are eligible to vote in elections if they are present at the election meeting.
- District contact Couples (Lay and Clergy) will each have one vote (one vote per couple) in the election.
- In order for a couple to be elected, they must receive more than 50% of the votes eligible to be cast. In the event that no couple receives a majority of the votes in a ballot, the couple with the fewest votes will be eliminated and another vote taken. Couples receiving no votes shall also be eliminated. In the event of a tie vote, for a couple to be eliminated, all couples will continue to remain eligible and a re-vote will be taken after a short interval or reflection and prayer.




#### EMAIL PRAYER CHAIN
