How are your Re-writes Coming?

- 10 TALKS --Please note that all 10 talks (remember there are only 10 now) are posted on the www.ilme.org website. Go to: "Resources for couples who have been on a Weekend" > "Presenting Couples" (password: LME/pc) >find CPO talks. There is now a folder for each talk, and under each talk you will find: the Skeleton Outline, the Outline and Mentality, a template (which many find simplifies the writing because all of the formatting is done for you and the suggested wording is already placed in the talk; however, be sure you DO read the outline—don't depend on the template for your content guide), and the new Workbook pages that will go with each talk numbered separately for each talk.
- 3rd SET RESPONSIBILITY—The goal set by NAR is to transition into all new talks by this September. However, realistically, as we transition into the new talks, there may need to be some adjustments. It will be up to the 3rd Set/Admin couple to ascertain where each of your writers are as you prepare for a given Weekend to make sure the team is all on the same page. So a given Weekend may be using some old and some new talks if absolutely necessary. (One caution if you do the new Self, you need to do the new Risk; otherwise we leave Aldonza without transforming her into Dulcinea.)
- WORKBOOKS --We are going to try having each area take the copy to FedEx/Kinkos to have your workbooks printed, so plan to make the number of copies needed for a given Weekend. (Find the complete workbook in the same section with the talks.) Please use your state tax exempt form to get the best price. The workbook will have "Lutheran Marriage Encounter" on the front cover and the Lutheran Communion statement at the end; otherwise, it is the CPO pages that all faith

expressions received. (Some faith expressions may choose to do revisions, or some use the all-in-one Workbook spiral, so there may be some differences in Workbooks.) If your writers are not all finished, this may involve taking a copy for a given Weekend that has some pages from the old workbook and some from the new. We're assuming that we should request that the first page be printed in color and the rest of the pages in black and white to get the best price.


