Voting Sacraments into the Invitation to Mission Process

- We conducted the post Weekend meeting on Zoom after all of the attendees had 'left' following the completion of the closing Liturgy. We reviewed the criteria for eligibility and prayed, invoking the Holy Spirit.
- We discussed options for voting and chose to simply text our ballot to the presenting priest. A Thumbs Up was a Yes vote on the entire slate. Texting the Sacrament's name was a 'No' vote for that Sacrament only.

Sharing in the Dream Contributions

- This portion of the Experience could not be completed until after all of the Donation envelopes were returned in the mail. We asked the attendees to mail them on Monday following the Experience. We sent a reminder mid week via email.
- We reconvened on Zoom the Sunday following the Experience and spent some time catching up and sharing the blessings of our week. We then prayed and opened the envelopes as we would on any in person Experience, reading off and recording the donations.
- We did not have 100% return on the donation envelopes. We received 6 out of 8 envelopes in the mail. (We unfortunately did not expect to receive an envelope from one Sacrament in attendance and the other was an elderly couple who may have not understood the directions.) During an in-person Experience we typically receive at least one empty envelope in the basket at the end of the weekend. We counted the missing envelope as simply an 'empty' envelope and did not pursue it, especially in the current economic climate.
